Your Board also met during the NAASC congress and several new initiatives were passed. The Board approved funding for two membership development strategies. Funds will be directed at forming new clubs as there are already new centres on the horizon. A co-op fund is also available for financial support to clubs for a membership campaign or event. Your Club Presidents, PR & Com and SICAN reps have already received information on these new initiatives.

Two new committees were also formed with representatives from the Board and members at large. A Long Term Planning Committee will begin strategizing for the future of Skål Canada including revenue generation and membership development. In addition, a Marketing Committee was established to look at resources needed by SICAN and Clubs to have the tools necessary to help build membership.

The broad mission statement of Skål 'doing business amongst friends' will take on a more prominent role in the future with a renewed focus on rebranding and promotion of the tangible benefits of generating business with other Skål members. Clubs are already developing programming specifically for networking and business exchange opportunities. More on this to come!
